MORNING SERVICE



At shul, the first thing people say when they come into
shul is Ma Tovu:



BARECHU

When people first arrive in shul, they read through a number of psalms and other prayers on their own. Then they come to a point where the most important prayers are about to be said and they all join in together. As each line is sung, people bow their heads, so we often call this the 'nodding prayer'.

Everyone stands up

Everyone sits down and sings a song to remind us what to do when we say the Shema

First we can do the actions:

SHHHHH... **(finger on lips)** let's be quiet

MMMMMMM... **(fingers on chin)** let's think - Who is God?

AAAAH... **(finger in the air)** God is One, God is one of a kind

And when you say the Shema, you put it there (put hand over eyes)



TORAH SERVICE



Two children open the ark. Everyone stands up, facing the ark and sings:

Ki miTzion tei'tsei Torah כִּי מִצִּיּוֹן תֵּצֵא תוֹרָה
Ud'var Adonai mi'rushalayim וּדְבַר יְהוָה מִירוּשָׁלַיִם.

Because from Zion the Torah goes out, and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

Baruch shenatan Torah בְּרוּךְ שֶׁנָּתַן תוֹרָה
L'amo Yisrael bi-k'dushato לְעַמּוֹ יִשְׂרָאֵל בְּקִדְשׁוֹ.

Blessed is He who gave the Law to His people Israel in holiness



Children or leader hold a Sefer Torah facing the congregation and sing the first two lines call-and-response style. The last line is sung together whilst bowing towards the ark.

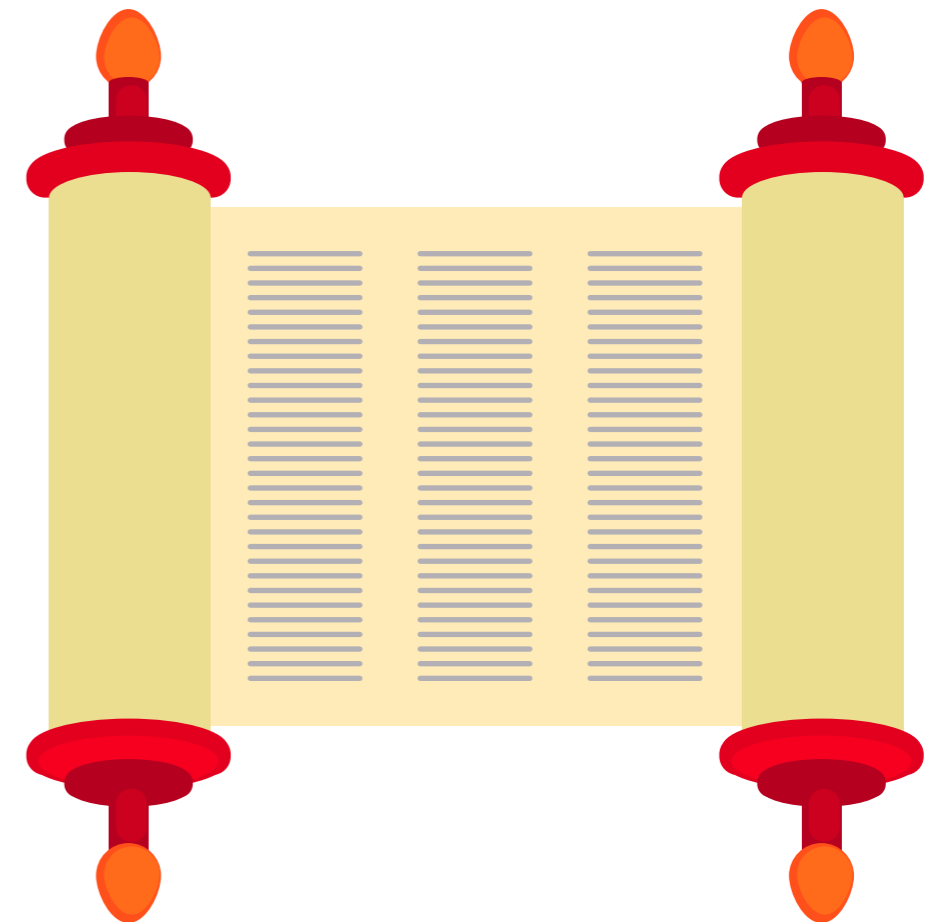

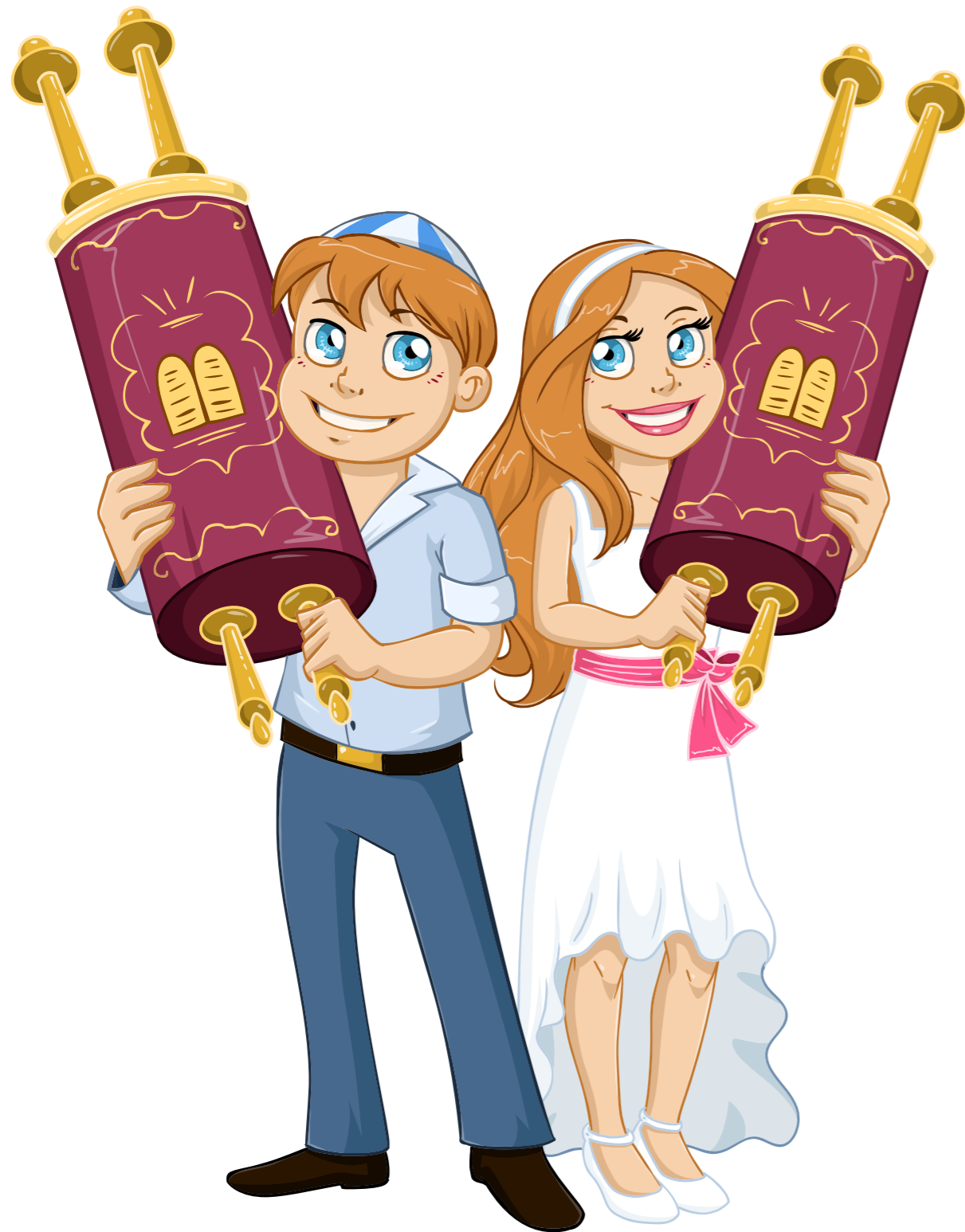

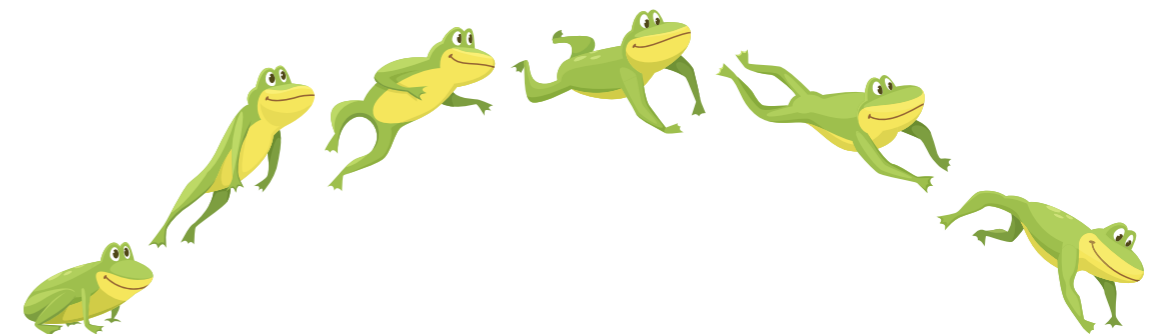
